The diagram provides a window onto the intellectual and spiritual practices of the medieval monks of the Cistercian abbey of Kamp.

Allegorical exegesis is concerned with taking a mode of writing that is not directly applicable to a subject matter and applying it to that subject matter. For instance, in Gregory of Nyssa's *The Life of Moses* the literal-historical account of the Exodus from Egypt takes on symbolic significance when applied to our own human journey from the slavery of vice to the freedom of virtue.

In fact, Allegorical Exegesis was the predominant way Christians read the Old Testament up until the 17th-18th centuries, at which time Literal Exegesis came to the forefront.
