Cut the 1-by-2-inch strip into three pieces, one as long as the length of the panels and two as long as the width. The two shorter pieces need to fit the width of your wood panels. The longer piece fits between these two pieces and covers the width. After cutting, place the strips onto the panel as a "dry run."

Take the bottom shelf and the 48" x 14" board to create the 1/2" border around its perimeter. Apply glue to the ends of the dowel legs and position the shelf. Pre-drill and then drive a screw into the end of each dowel leg to secure the bottom shelf. Carefully flip the shelf over and drive screws through the top shelf into the dowel legs.

The boards were all 4-5 metres long so that was a relief! This weekend we started building (mainly Klemens, I was more of an assistant). First thing he did was to cut 2 boards lengthwise, mainly because we needed our shelf to be 25cm wide, but the boards we got were only 20cm wide each, so he put together two times 12,5 to get the right width.
