(2) Look first in the Warrant Register for Northampton County (Carbon County was created from Northumberland Co. in 1843, but nearly all of the earliest landowners purchased before that time). Entries are arranged by the first letter of a person's surname, and then entered in a roughly chronological order by warrant date.

Carbon County Resources - Ancestor Tracks

This index was created from records at the Pennsylvania State Archives and indexes the warrants from all 67 counties in Pennsylvania, beginning in 1733, when warrant registers were first kept. Remember that county boundaries can change over time, and a warrant will be associated with the county as it was on the date of the warrant.
