I often find that home health nurses forget to document a complete head to toe assessment with every visit. It doesn't matter if you've seen the patient 10x or 200x before- you still need to document the entire physical assessment.

CHARTING AND DOCUMENTATION help! - Home Health Nursing ...

You're not eligible for the home health benefit if you need more than part-time or "intermittent" skilled nursing care. You may leave home for medical treatment or short, infrequent absences for non-medical reasons, like attending religious services. You can still get home health care if you attend adult day care.

The last section of documentation is focused on recommending steps you as the provider will take to assist the patient and caregiver in achieving the overall goals and plan of care. We can use this section to highlight the shared decision making between you and the patient regarding the plan for the next visit.

Home Care Medical Necessity Documentation. Medical review of home care charts, from many different organizations, has haunted home care agencies over the past couple of years. Lack of adequate Face to Face documentation has led to the highest percentage of denials. In addition, one of the top denial reasons, resulting from Additional Development Requests (ADR), Recovery Audits (RA) or Zone Program Integrity Contractor (ZPIC) reviews, is the lack of adequate medical necessity documentation!

Nursing documentation, such as patient care documents, assessments of processes, and outcome measures across organizational settings, serve to monitor performance of health care practitioners' and the health care facility's compliance with standards governing the profession and provision of health care. Such documentation is used to determine what credentials will be granted to health care practitioners within the organization.
