Make sure your Xbox One is on. You can either turn on the Xbox One by pressing the Xbox logo button on a wireless controller, or by pressing the Xbox logo button on the far right side of the console. 2 Press the eject button.

Follow the slot from the front locate the first "single" slot (it's the slot not grouped with any other slots) in the vent. Shine a light down through this slot to locate the manual eject screw. Grab the disc by hand, and pull it out of the slot. Once you remove the stuck disc, please put back HDD Bay Cover.

PS4: Manually Eject a Stuck Disc - PlayStation

Gently put the tweezers between the padding the disc slides in and out trough, push eject and a little panel behind the padding should slide out of the way, quickly get the tweezers past the panel so it doesn't shut on you. Grab the disc and pull on it, it may take a minute or a few tries.

To manually eject the CD/DVD drive tray from a Sony® CD/DVD drive, insert a pointed object, such as a paper clip, into the manual eject hole. NOTES: Not all CD/DVD drives have a manual eject hole. For example, slot loading optical drives do not have a manual eject option.

To eject the tray within the Operating System, follow these steps: Press the Windows key + E to open Windows Explorer or File Explorer. Click on Computer or My PC on the left pane of the window. Right-click on the CD/DVD/Blu-ray drive icon and select Eject.

Locate the first single vent (the one not grouped with other vents.) Shine a light through this vent to locate the manual eject screw. Slide the screwdriver into the vent and turn the screw anti-clockwise until the disc can be seen peeking out of the disc slot. This may require several turns of the screw.
