Dr Potter's second major publication was on Rhesus haemolytic disease, published in 1947.⁵ However, her most important contribution to the medical literature was undoubtedly a magnum opus, titled Pathology of the fetus and newborn (subsequently changed to "infant"), first published in 1953,⁶ with later editions in 1961, and then with John M Craig in 1975.
