HAND, WRIST, AND FOREARM DISORDERS GUIDELINE

The principle here is that if you can “shake hands with your work”, you are minimizing excessive reach and maintaining a neutral posture. Working from the power / comfort / handshake zone ensures that you are working from proper heights and reaches, which reduces MSD risk factors and allows for more efficient and pain-free work.

The wrist is an intricate joint with complex motion and function and is comprised of several articulations. These articulations are formed by various anatomical structures with varying degrees of curvatures and congruencies supported by the ligamentous elements, controlled by musculotendinous units, and based on precise proprioceptive input from various ligaments.
