Suicide was the tenth leading cause of death overall in the United States, claiming the lives of over 47,000 people. Suicide was the second leading cause of death among individuals between the ages of 10 and 34, and the fourth leading cause of death among individuals between the ages of 35 and 54.

Teen suicide is a growing health concern. It is the second-leading cause of death for young people ages 15 to 24, surpassed only by accidents, according to the U.S. Center for Disease Control and Prevention.

Teen Suicide Is Preventable

Suicide is the second leading cause of death - following motor vehicle accidents - among teenagers and young adults. On average, adolescents aged 15 to 19 years have an annual suicide rate of about 1 in 10,000 people. Among youths 12 to 16 year of age, up to 10% of boys and 20% of girls have considered suicide.

Unfortunately, suicide crosses all ages, racial, and socioeconomic groups in the US and around the world. In the US, suicide is the 2nd leading cause of death among children and adolescents ages 10-24, and the 3rd leading cause of death among 12 year olds. Nearly one of every eight children between the ages 6 and 12 has suicidal thoughts.

Given that thoughts about suicide appear to be quite common among adolescents (Lewinsohn, Rhode, & Seeley, 1996), some researchers suggest that suicidal ideation during high school age adolescents is normative (Marckeno, Fishman, & Friedman, 1999). The meaning and developmental course of suicidal thoughts in early adolescence is, however, not well understood.

Thoughts of Death and Suicide in Early Adolescence

Suicide is now the second leading cause of death for teens and young adults in the United States. Experts don't know why this rate has been rising. But NIH-funded researchers are working on better ways to find and help teens who are thinking of suicide. "There are some very effective treatments for youth who are suicidal," Pearson explains.
