The Decipherment Process. The story of the decipherment of Linear B begins with its first discovery at Knossos on Crete. A Greek businessman and antiquarian, Minos Kalokairinos, conducted excavations at the site in 1878; he was probably the first modern excavator to discover a Linear B tablet, as in 1895 Sir Arthur Evans saw a single tablet at Herakleion which most likely originated from Kalokairinos' excavations.
