The principles of art (or the principles of design) are essentially a set of criteria which are used to explain how the visual elements are arranged in a work of art. These principles are possibly the closest thing we have to a set of objective criteria for analyzing and judging art.

If the elements of art are your tools, the principles of art are how you put them to work. It is where the style of art manipulates its substance. Rhythm, harmony, balance, contrast, movement, proportion, and variety are the principles of art.

Dominance/Emphasis. The principle of visual organization that suggests that certain elements should assume more importance than others in the same composition. It contributes to organic unity by emphasizing the fact that there is one main feature and that other elements are subordinate to it.

The technical theory of art says that all art is a means to some end. Knowing that end, the makers of art are practicing a craft, because they are making an artifact in order to satisfy a pre-determined end. (An artifact is a material thing that is designed and made by a human being.)

R. G. Collingwood on defining art

R. G. Collingwood (1889–1943) was primarily a philosopher of history, a metaphysician and archaeologist, and considered his work in aesthetics—the principal work being his *The Principles of Art* (1938)—as secondary (for more about his general philosophy, see the entry on Robin George Collingwood). But the work in aesthetics has enjoyed a persistent readership that continues into the present.
